【Important Notice Regarding COVID-19】

The impact of the COVID-19 still continues. As recruiting exchange students for Fall 2021, the following precautions are required. We will only accept applicants who agree to all of these precautions.

- ① In accordance with the Japanese government policies, the entry into Japan from all countries and regions has been suspended for the time being from January 14, 2021. Even if your students are allowed to enter Japan in the future, it is expected that they will be allowed to enter under certain conditions for the time being.

- ③ In order to prevent the spread of infection, restrictions on activities (e.g., prohibition of travel to distant places) and restrictions on part-time jobs (e.g., prohibition of part-time work) may be imposed.
