## 【Important Notice Regarding COVID-19】

The impact of the COVID-19 still continues. As recruiting exchange students for Spring 2023, the following precautions are required. We will only accept applicants who agree to all of these precautions.

- ① Some countries/regions are designated by the Japanese government as countries/regions subject to landing refusal and new entry are temporarily suspended. In addition, there are various restrictions on entry into Japan even in cases where new entry is allowed.
